

EU Data Act Information Notice (“Notice”)

Last updated: 23 June 2026

This Notice explains how Checkit Europe Limited (“Checkit”, “we”, “our” or “us”) makes certain data generated through the use of our connected products and related services available in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2023/2854 (the “EU Data Act”).

1. About Checkit

Checkit provides connected monitoring devices, sensors, software platforms and operational intelligence services, including IoT-enabled monitoring, alerting, workflow and analytics solutions.

For the purposes of the EU Data Act, Checkit may act as a manufacturer of connected products, provider of related services and/or a data holder.

2. Connected products and related services

Under the EU Data Act:

- “connected products” are products capable of obtaining, generating or collecting data concerning their use or environment and communicating that data electronically; and
- “related services” are digital services connected with a product in such a way that the product could not perform one or more of its functions without them. Checkit connected products and related services may include:
 - wireless environmental sensors;
 - gateways and communications devices;
 - refrigeration and asset monitoring devices;

- cloud-hosted monitoring platforms;
- mobile and web interfaces;
- alerting and escalation systems;
- workflow and compliance management tools; and
- operational analytics and predictive monitoring features.

3. Categories of data generated

Depending on the deployed solution, enabled functionality and customer configuration, Checkit connected products and related services may generate or process the following categories of data:

- Sensor and environmental data - temperature, humidity, pressure and environmental readings;
- Device and operational data - battery status, connectivity status, firmware version, uptime and signal strength;
- Usage and interaction data - user acknowledgements, workflow actions, task completion records and system interactions;
- Alert and event data - threshold breaches, incidents, alarms, escalations and notification records;
- Asset and deployment data - device identifiers, asset identifiers, deployment location and site references;
- Diagnostic and maintenance data - error logs, health diagnostics, maintenance records and troubleshooting information; and
- Analytics and performance data - trends, operational metrics, predictive alerts and asset intelligence outputs.

4. Access to data

Where the EU Data Act applies, users of Checkit connected products and related services may have rights to:

- access data generated through their use of connected products and related services;
- request that such data be made available to a third party; and
- receive certain information regarding how such data is used.

Checkit will provide access to relevant data in accordance with applicable law, contractual arrangements, confidentiality obligations, intellectual property rights and security requirements.

Checkit may refuse or limit access where permitted by applicable law, including where disclosure would adversely affect security, confidentiality or the rights of third parties.

5. Personal Data

Some data generated through the use of Checkit connected products and related services may constitute personal data under applicable data protection laws.

Our processing activities are described further in the Checkit Privacy Notice. Where Checkit acts as a processor on behalf of customers, processing will also be governed by the Checkit Data Processing Agreement, unless agreed otherwise.

6. Security and confidentiality

Checkit implements technical and organisational measures designed to protect data against unauthorised access, loss, misuse or disclosure.

Nothing in this notice requires Checkit to disclose source code, algorithms, proprietary models, confidential security information or trade secrets except where required by applicable law.

7. Changes to this Notice

We may update this notice from time to time to reflect changes in applicable law, our products and services or our operational practices.
